Attorney General Greg Abbott needs the public's help to find Child Support Evader Larry Lewis. Lewis owes almost \$12,000 for the support of his 16-year-old son, who lives with his mother in Abilene. Lewis was added to the Attorney General's Most Wanted List of Child Support Evaders in July 2001, and has gone underground to elude officials and avoid arrest on his child support case.

In March 1999, a Taylor County judge ordered Lewis to make monthly child support payments of \$178. He soon fell behind, and by June 2000 owed \$2,848 in unpaid child support. Lewis was given many chances to pay what he owed. When he failed to appear at a December 2000 court hearing, a warrant was issued for his arrest. Lewis has not made a payment in over three years. Due to missed payments and interest that accrues on unpaid child support, he now owes \$11,909.

Lewis may be hiding in Abilene and is most likely working for cash to avoid automatic garnishment of wages to pay his child support obligation. Lewis is considered dangerous by law enforcement authorities and, in addition to child support, is wanted on a felony parole violation.

The Child Support Evaders on the most wanted list are being singled out because they have the ability to take responsibility for their children, but refuse to do so. Incarceration is the only option for parents who flagrantly ignore a court's order to pay child support. The Attorney General's Office helps parents who lack the ability to pay child support by referring them to job training and employment services.

POINTS TO REMEMBER

CHILD SUPPORT EVADERS

Criteria for a parent to be named a Most Wanted Child Support Evader:

- ▶ Court-ordered delinquent support must be in excess of \$5,000
- ▶ Arrest warrant must have been issued for non-support
- ▶ Location of non-custodial parent is unknown
- ▶ Parent has not made any payments in the last six months
- ▶ Non-custodial parent must not be involved in bankruptcy proceedings
- ▶ Non-custodial parent must not be receiving welfare benefits

Because we must make Child Support information public, the custodial parent must sign a confidentiality waiver.
