



CHILD SUPPORT EVADER JIMMIE McCULLOUGH

your help locating Child Support Evader Jimmie McCullough, one of the Most Wanted Child Support Evaders in Texas. McCullough, who was added to the Child Support Evader list in May 2009, owes \$138,291 for the care of two sons.

When the parents divorced, McCullough was ordered to pay \$300 per month in child support. McCullough, who had the ability to make his payments, did not follow the court's order to support his children financially.

In 2000, as a result of the Office of the Attorney General's enforcement action, the court determined that McCullough owed \$58,000 in unpaid child support and gave him a suspended jail sentence so that he could begin paying off his debt. Since 2000, McCullough has been given many opportunities to pay what he owes. His repeated violations of court orders to pay child support resulted in an arrest warrant being

issued for failure to appear at a June 2005 court hearing.

McCullough has not made a single child support payment in more than four years. By refusing to provide the financial resources his sons need, McCullough has turned his back on his children and violated the law. A combination of missed payments and interest that accrues on unpaid child support adds up to \$138,000 in unpaid child support McCullough now owes.

Investigators from the Office of the Attorney General's Office have searched the state for McCullough. His last known address was in Texarkana, TX. He may be working for cash or self employed to avoid garnishment of wages to pay child support. Texas law requires the Office of the Attorney General to publicly identify certain parents who are delinquent in the payment of child support. The Child Support Evaders are selected because they have the ability to take responsibility for their children but refuse to do so. Incarceration is the only option for parents who repeatedly ignore court orders to pay child support. The Attorney General's Office helps parents who lack the ability to pay child support by referring them to job training and employment services.

POINTS TO REMEMBER



MOST WANTED EVADERS

For a parent to be named as a Most Wanted Child Support Evader:

- Court-ordered delinquent support must be in excess of \$5,000
- Arrest warrant must have been issued for non support
- Location of noncustodial parent is unknown
- Parent has not made any payments in the last six months
- Noncustodial parent must not be involved in bankruptcy proceedings
- Noncustodial parent must not be receiving welfare benefits

In order to make child support information public, the custodial parent must sign a confidentiality waiver.
