



When Victor Rivers was 12-years-old, he went to the police to report a lifetime of crime that was inflicted upon him and his family. His mother, siblings and even pets were affected. Though the officers were horrified at the abuse they saw, they told him there was little they could do, it was a private family matter they stated. When the violence became unbearable, young Rivers took unprecedented legal action against his father. Rivers went on to live with a series of foster families who empowered him to go from gang member to class president.
