The Office of the Attorney General (“OAG”) received a citizen complaint, pursuant to section 411.209 of the Government Code, concerning the wrongful exclusion of handgun license holders from Abilene City Hall. Based on this representation, the OAG concludes the City of Abilene’s voluntary compliance has resolved the issue. Therefore, the OAG is closing this complaint.
