The Office of the Attorney General (“OAG”) received a citizen complaint, pursuant to section 411.209 of the Government Code, concerning the alleged wrongful exclusion of handgun license holders from the Woodway Police Department. While reviewing this complaint, the OAG received an email from Public Safety Director Yost Zakhary stating the signage that formed the basis of the complaint had been removed and replaced with a sign posted directly outside the entrance to the municipal court referring to Penal Code § 46.03(a)(3). Based on this representation, the OAG concludes the City of Woodway’s voluntary compliance has resolved the issue. Therefore, the OAG is closing this complaint.
