
Dear Mr. Landers:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 9268.

We have considered the exception you claimed, and have reviewed the documents at issue. A previous determination of this office, Open Records Decision No. 506 (1988), a copy of which is enclosed, resolves your request. For this reason, the marked portions of the document, i.e., the police chief's mobile phone number and home phone number, are excepted from disclosure. The balance of the record is public information. With respect to your claim regarding telephone calls to or from informants, the submitted representative information reveals no such information. Consequently, we have no basis for considering this claim. Should you wish to assert this claim with respect to a specific record, the record must be submitted with an explanation of how the information comes within an exception to public disclosure in the Open Records Act.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR90-308.
