Dear Senator McFarland:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 11016.

We have considered the exception you claimed, and have reviewed the documents at issue. The requested information constitutes working papers involved in the preparation of proposed legislation by an individual with a responsibility to prepare proposals for a legislative body. As such, they are excepted from required disclosure by section 3(a)(6). See generally Open Records Decision No. 460 (1987). Consequently, you may withhold the requested information.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR91-070.
