
Dear Mr. Peck:

This letter is in reference to your correspondence of August 14, 1991, which has been assigned ID#13292. We are advised that you are consulting with the *Ruiz* plaintiffs as to whether requested information is "sensitive" within the *Stipulated Modification to the Ruiz Amended Decree*.

In order to avoid holding a file open indefinitely, we will close the file on this matter until such time as you advise that a determination has been made that the information is not "sensitive" within the meaning of the *Stipulated Modification*. At that time we will consider the exception to required public disclosure under section 3(a) of the Open Records Act which you have asserted. We understand your need under the *Stipulated Modification* to determine whether information is "sensitive" as well as your concern that your request for an open records decision be considered timely. This office will consider your request for a decision with respect to this matter to be timely under section 7.

Should further consideration of the exception under section 3(a) of the Open Records Act which you have asserted be required, or if you decide that the requested information is "sensitive," please notify this office, and include a reference to ID# 13292 and OR91-464.
