Dear Mr. Beversdorff:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 14554.

You have received a request for a copy of a former Texas Youth Commission employee's grievance file. You have released to the requestor information responsive to the request. You claim, however, that one document contained in the file is excepted from required public disclosure by the attorney-client privilege as incorporated by section 3(a)(7) into the Open Records Act.

Having examined the document submitted to us for review, we conclude that it may be withheld from required public disclosure under section 3(a)(7) of the Open Records Act. *See* Open Records Decision No. 574 (1990).

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with

a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR92-27.
