Dear Mr. Delmore:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 14110. As the requested information in ID# 14110 completely subsumes the requested information in ID# 13835, we are combining these two files for purposes of resolving of your request.

We have considered the exceptions you claimed, and have reviewed the records at issue. You advise that criminal litigation regarding the subject matter of the requested records remains subject to further proceedings. For this reason, you may withhold the requested information under section 3(a)(3) of the Open Records Act. As section 3(a)(3) resolves your request, we need not consider the other exceptions you raised.

We are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR92-33.
