Dear Mr. Dempsey:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 12452.

You assert that the requested information is excepted by section 3(a)(1) of the Open Records Act in conjunction with subsection (g) of section 143.089 of the Local Government Code. Because you believe subsection (g) forbids the release of the information to this office under the Open Records Act, you have declined to submit copies of the requested records. You have asserted this claim in connection with other similar requests. Our office responded to your claim in letter ruling OR91-566, which we hereby incorporate into this ruling.

Accordingly, because your request for an open records decision remains incomplete, this office lacks the necessary information to evaluate your claim under section 3(a)(1). We are therefore closing the file without a finding, and the person requesting the information on this occasion may pursue such remedies as may be appropriate. *See e.g.*, V.T.C.S. art. 6252-17a, § 8.

In light of these developments, we are resolving this matter with this informal

letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR92-157.
