Dear Mr. Hubbarth:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, article 6252-17a, V.T.C.S. Your request was assigned ID# 16682.

The Texas Department of Criminal Justice has received a request for certain information relating to an employee disciplinary action. You claim that the requested information is excepted from required public disclosure by section 3(a)(3) of the Open Records Act. We have examined the documents submitted to us for review and conclude that previous determinations of this office resolve your request. See Open Records Decision No. 551 (1990) (copy enclosed). Accordingly, the requested information may be withheld from required public disclosure under section 3(a)(3) of the Open Records Act.

Because case law and prior published open records decisions resolve your request, we are resolving this matter with this informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. If you have questions about this ruling, please refer to OR92-493.
