This is to inform you that we have received a letter from Mr. Gerald Thurmond, representative of Chevron U.S.A. Products Company, dated June 22, 1994, pertaining to our file ID# 26230. Mr. Thurmond indicates that Chevron waives its trade secret interests in the information requested by Mr. Harold Duncan under the Texas Open Records Act, chapter 552 of the Government Code.

Because the third party interests have been waived and you have not raised any other exceptions, we have no basis for applying to this information any exceptions to required public disclosure. See Open Records Decision No. 552 (1990). Therefore, because neither you nor Chevron U.S.A. Products Company have contended to this office that the requested information should be withheld, you should release the information at this time.
