Dear Ms. Grace:

You ask this office to reconsider our ruling in Open Records Letter No. 98-0204 (1998). Your request for reconsideration was assigned ID# 115116.

The City of Houston (the "city") received a request for all incident reports that occurred on specified dates at the requestor's address. In Open Records Letter No. 98-0204 (1998), this office concluded that the city could not withhold the requested information under section 552.108 of the Government Code.

You have clarified that release of the requested information would interfere with the investigation and/or prosecution of crime because it relates to an ongoing investigation and the statute of limitations has not expired. We, therefore, conclude that you may withhold the requested information under section 552.108(a)(1). Open Records Letter No. 98-0204 (1998) is overruled to the extent it conflicts with this ruling.
