Dear Mr. Davis:

You have asked whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 120377.

The City of Fort Worth (the "city") received a request for the "names and addresses of the retirees eligible to vote in the 1998 Retiree representative election for Place 8." You explain that these retirees are former public employees and that a number of them have opted, pursuant to sections 552.024 and 552.117 of the Government Code, to have their home addresses withheld from public disclosure. You seek to withhold the home addresses of those retirees who, as of the date of the request for information, had opted to have their home addresses withheld from disclosure. We agree that the city must withhold from disclosure the home addresses of those former employees who, in accordance with sections 552.024 and 552.117, elected to keep this information confidential.

We are resolving this matter with an informal letter ruling rather than with a published open records decision. This ruling is limited to the particular records at issue under the facts presented to us in this request and should not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other records.
