Dear Ms. Sela:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Texas Open Records Act, chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 120455.

The Dallas Police Department (the "department") received a request for the name(s) of the individual(s) who reported that the requestor's car is being parked illegally in front of his home. You contend that the originating telephone numbers and addresses from the call sheets are excepted from required public disclosure by section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 772.318 of the Health and Safety Code. We believe that a prior ruling, Open Records Letter No. 98-2551 (1998) answers your question concerning originating telephone numbers and addresses on 911 call reports. You may rely upon ORL 98-2551 (enclosed) as a previous determination on this issue under section 552.301 of the Government Code and thus need not ask this office again for a decision concerning these types of records.
