You claim that the orange highlighted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the orange highlighted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the orange highlighted information. Lastly, the social security numbers highlighted in green are confidential under section 552.147 of the Government Code.
