Dear Ms. Cho:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 323453.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined that your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim Exhibit B may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(2) you may withhold Exhibit B. However, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code. Also, you must withhold the marked Texas motor vehicle information in Exhibit C under section 552.130 of the Government Code. Lastly, you may withhold the marked social security numbers under section 552.147 of the Government Code.
