Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim that the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold most of the bracketed information. However, you must release the basic information, including a detailed description of the offense, pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
