Dear Ms. Brown:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 339005.

The Plano Police Department (the "department") received a request for a specified police report, arrest report, and audio and video from the transporting officer's car. You state the department is withholding all but "front page information" from the requested incident and offense reports based upon the ruling in *Attorney General v. Plano Police Department*, No. GV-001919 (126th Dist. Ct., Travis County, Tex., December 18, 2000) (stating the department may withhold an offense report related to a pending criminal case under section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code without seeking a decision from this office). You state you will release the basic "front page information" to the requestor. *See* Gov't Code § 552.108(c) (stating basic information about arrested person, arrest, or crime may not be withheld under section 552.108); Open Records Decision No. 127 (1976) (summarizing types of information considered to be basic information). You claim that the submitted video recording from the transporting officer's car is excepted from disclosure under section 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information. We have also considered comments submitted by the requestor. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (interested party may submit comments stating why information should or should not be released).

Section 552.108 of the Government Code excepts from disclosure "[i]nformation held by a law enforcement agency or prosecutor that deals with the detection, investigation, or

prosecution of crime . . . if . . . release of the information would interfere with the detection, investigation, or prosecution of crime[.]” *Id.* § 552.108(a)(1). A governmental body that claims an exception to disclosure under section 552.108 must reasonably explain how and why this exception is applicable to the information at issue. *See id.* § 552.301(e)(1)(A); *Ex parte Pruitt*, 551 S.W.2d 706 (Tex. 1977). You inform us that the submitted information relates to a pending criminal investigation and prosecution. Based upon your representation and our review, we find that section 552.108(a)(1) is applicable to the submitted audio/video tape from the transporting officer’s car. *See Houston Chronicle Publ’g Co. v. City of Houston*, 531 S.W.2d 177 (Tex. Civ. App.—Houston [14th Dist.] 1975), *writ ref’d n.r.e.*, 536 S.W.2d 559 (Tex. 1976) (per curiam) (court delineates law enforcement interests that are present in active cases). The department may, therefore, withhold the submitted video recording from the transporting officer’s car pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We note that you have the discretion to release all or part of the submitted information that is not otherwise confidential by law. Gov’t Code § 552.007.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
