The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 344392.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim Exhibits C and D may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold Exhibits C and D. We agree you must withhold the marked Texas drivers license number in Exhibit B in accordance with section 552.130 of the Government Code. Also, you may withhold the social security number(s) under section 552.147 of the Government Code. However, because you make no arguments for withholding the telephone number you marked in Exhibit B, You must release it. *See Gov't Code §§ 552.301, 302.*
