Re: Request for info pertaining to the years 2007-2009 for all individuals, including named parties and address and for a copy of incident report in 2004 regarding near drowning of named person

Dear Ms. Allen:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 350528.

The requestor seeks 1) information concerning three individuals and an address, 2) a near drowning report, and 3) an assault report. You state "all information responsive to the request is enclosed." The submitted information is responsive to item 1. Thus we assume you have information responsive to items 2 and 3. After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information may be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
