The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 490121.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim report number 13-044170 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold report number 13-044170. However, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code. Because you have not submitted arguments objecting to the release of the remaining submitted information, you must release it. *See Gov't Code § 552.301(e).*
