Re: Request for all items pertaining to a named individual; all records pertaining to the investigation of any crime and/or incident involving the individual, any questioning in connection with any crime and/or incident and any arrest and/or detention of the individual; including offense reports, witness statements, incident reports, calls for service, investigative reports, case summaries, criminal history reports; etc.

Dear Ms. Gonzalez:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 492840.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information may be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
