Dear Ms. Henry:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 487416 (Plano ORR No. EBEB022113)

The Plano Police Department (the "department") received a request for eleven categories of information regarding a specified accident. You claim that the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Initially, we note the department only submitted a compact disc with videos of the specified accident. To the extent information responsive to the rest of the request existed at the time of the request, we assume the department has released it to the requestor. If not, then the department must do so immediately. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.006, .301, .302; Open Records Decision No. 664 (2000).

Section 552.130 of the Government Code excepts from public disclosure information relating to a motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country. *See* Gov't Code § 552.130(a)(2). The submitted video recordings contain license plate numbers that are excepted from disclosure under section 552.130(a)(2). Because the department states it lacks the technological capability to redact such information from these video recordings, we agree the department must withhold the entire video recordings under section 552.130(a)(2) of the Government Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
