Dear Mr. Atkinson:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 495963 (PIR# W026034).

The Fort Worth Police Department (the "department") received a request for information pertaining to a specified accident. You claim the requested information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

You inform us the requested information was the subject of a previous request for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2013-09222 (2013). In that ruling, we concluded the department may withhold the information at issue under section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code, except for basic information under section 552.108(c) and a statutory warning; and must withhold the information we marked in the statutory warning under section 552.130 of the Government Code. As there is no indication of any change in the law, facts, and circumstances on which the previous ruling is based, we conclude the department must dispose of the requested information in accordance with Open Records Letter No. 2013-09222. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 at 6-7 (2001) (so long as law, facts, and circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where requested information is precisely same information as was addressed in prior attorney

general ruling, ruling is addressed to same governmental body, and ruling concludes that information is or is not excepted from disclosure).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
