Re: Request for all Fort Worth police records involving a named individual (DOB 09/02/1960) including, but not limited to, charges brought against him for bodily injury to another named individual on or about 06/09/2005

Dear Mr. Cumbie:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 499540 (Fort Worth PIR# W026823).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. As for the request for information regarding a June 9, 2005 charge, we assume you have released it to the extent it exists because you have not submitted it to this office. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302.
