Dear Ms. Brown:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 504142 (Tracking# FOSP082113).

The Plano Police Department (the "department") received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident. You state the department has released basic information. *See* Gov't Code § 552.108(c) (basic information about an arrested person, an arrest, or a crime is not excepted under section 552.108); *see also* Open Records Decision No. 127 (1976) (summarizing types of information considered to be basic information). You claim the remaining requested information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim.


We note the information at issue was the subject of a previous request for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2013-15573 (2013). In that ruling, we concluded the department may withhold the submitted information under section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have no indication the law, facts, and circumstances on which Open Records Letter No. 2013-15573 was based have changed. Accordingly, we conclude the department may continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2013-15573 as a previous determination and withhold the information at issue in accordance with that ruling. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (so long as law, facts, circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where requested information is precisely same information as was

addressed in prior attorney general ruling, ruling is addressed to same governmental body, and ruling concludes that information is or is not excepted from disclosure).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
