Dear Ms. Vieira:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 517570 (OGC# 153821).

The University of Texas at El Paso (the "university") received a request for all information related to a specified office space improvement project. Although the university takes no position with respect to the public availability of the submitted information, you state its release may implicate the proprietary interests of third parties. Accordingly, you provide documentation you notified the third parties of the request for information and of their right to submit arguments to this office as to why their information should not be released.¹ See

Gov't Code § 552.305(d); *see also* Open Records Decision No. 542 (1990) (determining that statutory predecessor to section 552.305 permits governmental body to rely on interested third party to raise and explain applicability of exception to disclosure in certain circumstances). We have received comments from representatives of Beltran stating Beltran does not object to the release of its submitted information. We also have received comments from representatives of A&P and Benning. We have considered the submitted arguments and reviewed the submitted information.

Initially, you acknowledge, and we agree, the university has not complied with the time periods prescribed by section 552.301 of the Government Code in seeking an open records decision from this office. Gov't Code § 552.301. When a governmental body fails to comply with the procedural requirements of section 552.301, the information at issue is presumed public and must be released unless there is a compelling reason to withhold it. *See id.* § 552.302; *Simmons v. Kuzmich*, 166 S.W.3d 342, 350 (Tex. App.—Fort Worth 2005, no pet.); *Hancock v. State Bd. of Ins.*, 797 S.W.2d 379, 381-82 (Tex. App.—Austin 1990, no writ) (governmental body must make compelling demonstration to overcome presumption of openness pursuant to statutory predecessor to section 552.302); *see also* Open Records Decision No. 630 (1994). Generally, a governmental body may demonstrate a compelling reason to withhold information by a showing the information is made confidential by another source of law or affects third party interests. *See* Open Records Decision No. 150 at 2 (1977). Because third party interests are at stake in this instance, we will consider whether the information at issue must be withheld under the Act.

An interested third party is allowed ten business days after the date of its receipt of the governmental body's notice under section 552.305(d) to submit its reasons, if any, as to why information relating to that party should be withheld from public disclosure. *See* Gov't Code § 552.305(d)(2)(B). As of the date of this letter, we have not received comments from the remaining third parties explaining why their submitted information should not be released.

Empire Roofing; EPR Contractors, Inc.; Facilities Connection; FastSigns; Five Star Automatic Fire Protection; Flooring Perfections, Inc.; Funk & Company; Gateway Air Conditioning; Gibson Concrete; GNRB Remodeling & Painting; Gorham Electric, Inc.; Graybar; HSC Electric Co.; Hagen Builders Design L.P.; Hi-Tek Sound & Signal, Inc.; Imperial Casework, Inc.; J&J Remodeling; JACO General Contractors, Inc.; JLS Doors & Hardware; JMR Demolition, Ltd.; KD Scholton; Kennel Industrial, Inc.; Kings Aire, Inc.; L&W Supply; Longhorn Electric; Luis Doors & Closer Service; LVR Carpet Center, Inc.; Manny Carrizal Painting; MF Mechanical, Inc.; MFH Environmental Corp.; Millennium Electrical; Mini Concrete Materials; Mission Plumbing Co.; Mountain Electric Corp.; Nano's Glass, Inc.; NBS; Nevarez Millworks, Inc.; Nine Degrees Architecture & Design, Inc.; Par Flooring; Payless Plumbing; Performance Glass & Aluminum, Inc.; Prime Crete Enterprises, Inc.; Professional Paint Corp.; Puentes Concrete Contractors Corp.; Rayco Construction, Inc.; RC Concrete; Rio Bravo Electric; RNJ Concrete; Robles Service Group; Rocky Duron & Associates; Rodriguez Drywall & Paint Co.; SimplexGrinnell; Southwest Architectural Millwork; Southwest Décor; Southwest G.C.E.P., Inc.; Steel Specialties; Sunlight Electrical & Mechanical Co.; Suntech Mechanical, Inc.; Texas Chalkboard, Ltd.; Texas Door & Hardware; Texas Specialties Installation; Trimco Master Millwork L.P.; Trimco Plaster; TX Construction Enterprises, Inc.; Union Electrical Contractors; United Rentals; Universal Coating; Veliz Construction, LLC; and Wadleigh Tile L.P.

Therefore, we have no basis to conclude these third parties have a protected proprietary interest in the submitted information. *See id.* § 552.110; Open Records Decision Nos. 661 at 5-6 (1999) (to prevent disclosure of commercial or financial information, party must show by specific factual evidence, not conclusory or generalized allegations, that release of requested information would cause that party substantial competitive harm), 552 at 5 (1990) (party must establish *prima facie* case that information is trade secret), 542 at 3. Accordingly, the university may not withhold the submitted information on the basis of any proprietary interest the remaining third parties may have in the information.

A&P raises section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy for some of its information.² Section 552.101 excepts “information considered to be confidential by law, either constitutional, statutory, or by judicial decision.” Gov’t Code § 552.101. Section 552.101 encompasses the doctrine of common-law privacy, which protects information that is (1) highly intimate or embarrassing, the publication of which would be highly objectionable to a reasonable person, and (2) not of legitimate concern to the public. *Indus. Found. v. Tex. Indus. Accident Bd.*, 540 S.W.2d 668, 685 (Tex. 1976). To demonstrate the applicability of common-law privacy, both prongs of this test must be satisfied. *Id.* at 681-82. Types of information considered intimate and embarrassing by the Texas Supreme Court are delineated in *Industrial Foundation*. *Id.* at 683. However, we note common-law privacy protects the interests of individuals, not those of corporate and other business entities. *See* Open Records Decision Nos. 620 (1993) (corporation has no right to privacy), 192 (1978) (right to privacy is designed primarily to protect human feelings and sensibilities, rather than property, business, or other pecuniary interests); *see also Rosen v. Matthews Constr. Co.*, 777 S.W.2d 434 (Tex. App.—Houston [14th Dist.] 1989) (corporation has no right to privacy (citing *United States v. Morton Salt Co.*, 338 U.S. 632, 652 (1950))), *rev’d on other grounds*, 796 S.W.2d 692 (Tex. 1990). Upon review, we find A&P has failed to demonstrate the information at issue is highly intimate or embarrassing and of no legitimate public interest. Thus, the submitted information may not be withheld under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.

Benning raises section 552.110 of the Government Code for its information. Section 552.110 protects (1) trade secrets and (2) commercial or financial information the disclosure of which would cause substantial competitive harm to the person from whom the information was obtained. *See* Gov’t Code § 552.110(a)-(b). Section 552.110(a) protects trade secrets obtained from a person and privileged or confidential by statute or judicial decision. *Id.* § 552.110(a). The Texas Supreme Court has adopted the definition of trade secret from section 757 of the Restatement of Torts, which holds a trade secret to be:

any formula, pattern, device or compilation of information which is used in one's business, and which gives him an opportunity to obtain an advantage over competitors who do not know or use it. It may be a formula for a chemical compound, a process of manufacturing, treating or preserving materials, a pattern for a machine or other device, or a list of customers. It differs from other secret information in a business . . . in that it is not simply information as to single or ephemeral events in the conduct of the business A trade secret is a process or device for continuous use in the operation of the business. . . . [It may] relate to the sale of goods or to other operations in the business, such as a code for determining discounts, rebates or other concessions in a price list or catalogue, or a list of specialized customers, or a method of bookkeeping or other office management.

RESTATEMENT OF TORTS § 757 cmt. b (1939); *see also Hyde Corp. v. Huffines*, 314 S.W.2d 776 (Tex. 1958). In determining whether particular information constitutes a trade secret, this office considers the Restatement's definition of trade secret as well as the Restatement's list of six trade secret factors.³ RESTATEMENT OF TORTS § 757 cmt. b. This office must accept a claim that information subject to the Act is excepted as a trade secret if a *prima facie* case for the exception is made and no argument is submitted that rebuts the claim as a matter of law. *See* ORD 552 at 5. However, we cannot conclude section 552.110(a) is applicable unless it has been shown the information meets the definition of a trade secret and the necessary factors have been demonstrated to establish a trade secret claim. Open Records Decision No. 402 (1983). We note pricing information pertaining to a particular contract is generally not a trade secret because it is "simply information as to single or ephemeral events in the conduct of the business," rather than "a process or device for continuous use in the operation of the business." RESTATEMENT OF TORTS § 757 cmt. b; *see also Huffines*, 314 S.W.2d at 776; Open Records Decision Nos. 255, 232 (1979), 217 (1978).

³The Restatement of Torts lists the following six factors as indicia of whether information constitutes a trade secret:

- (1) the extent to which the information is known outside of [the company];
- (2) the extent to which it is known by employees and other involved in [the company's] business;
- (3) the extent of measures taken by [the company] to guard the secrecy of the information;
- (4) the value of the information to [the company] and [its] competitors;
- (5) the amount of effort or money expended by [the company] in developing the information;
- (6) the ease or difficulty with which the information could be properly acquired or duplicated by others.

RESTATEMENT OF TORTS § 757 cmt. b; *see also* Open Records Decision Nos. 319 at 2 (1982), 306 at 2 (1982), 255 at 2 (1980).

Section 552.110(b) protects “[c]ommercial or financial information for which it is demonstrated based on specific factual evidence that disclosure would cause substantial competitive harm to the person from whom the information was obtained[.]” Gov’t Code § 552.110(b). This exception to disclosure requires a specific factual or evidentiary showing, not conclusory or generalized allegations, that substantial competitive injury would likely result from release of the information at issue. *Id.*; *see also* Open Records Decision No. 661 at 5 (1999).

Benning asserts its information includes “company trade secrets, financial and commercial/competitive information, pricing information, and service detail” and is subject to section 552.110 of the Government Code. Upon review, we conclude Benning has failed to demonstrate any portion of information at issue meets the definition of a trade secret. *See* ORD 402 (section 552.110(a) does not apply unless information meets definition of trade secret and necessary factors have been demonstrated to establish trade secret claim). Further, we find Benning has made only conclusory allegations the release of any of its information would result in substantial harm to its competitive position. *See* ORD 661 (for information to be withheld under commercial or financial information prong of section 552.110, business must show by specific factual evidence that substantial competitive injury would result from release of particular information at issue). Accordingly, the university may not withhold any of the submitted information under section 552.110 of the Government Code.

Section 552.113 of the Government Code provides in relevant part as follows:

(a) Information is excepted from [required public disclosure] if it is:

...

(2) geological or geophysical information or data, including maps concerning wells, except information filed in connection with an application or proceeding before an agency; or

(3) confidential under Subsections (c) through (f).

...

(c) In this section:

(1) “Confidential material” includes all well logs, geological, geophysical, geochemical, and other similar data, including maps and other interpretations of the material filed in the General Land Office:

(A) in connection with any administrative application or proceeding before the land commissioner, the school land board, any board for lease, or the commissioner's or board's staff; or

(B) in compliance with the requirements of any law, rule, lease, or agreement.

...

(3) "Administrative applications" and "administrative proceedings" include applications for pooling or unitization, review of shut-in royalty payments, review of leases or other agreements to determine their validity, review of any plan of operations, review of the obligation to drill offset wells, or an application to pay compensatory royalty.

Gov't Code § 552.113(a)(2)-(3), (c)(1), (c)(3). Benning generally asserts its information is subject to section 552.113 of the Government Code. In Open Records Decision No. 627 (1994), this office concluded section 552.113(a)(2) protects from public disclosure only (i) geological and geophysical information regarding the exploration or development of natural resources that is (ii) commercially valuable. ORD 627 at 3-4 (overruling rationale of Open Records Decision No. 504 (1988)). Upon review, we find Benning has not demonstrated any of its information is commercially valuable geological or geophysical information regarding the exploration of or development of natural resources. Further, Benning has not demonstrated any of its information is confidential for purposes of section 552.113(a)(3). Accordingly, the university may not withhold any of the submitted information under section 552.113 of the Government Code.

Benning also claims its information is subject to section 552.131 of the Government Code. Section 552.131 relates to economic development information and provides in part:

(a) Information is excepted from [required public disclosure] if the information relates to economic development negotiations involving a governmental body and a business prospect that the governmental body seeks to have locate, stay, or expand in or near the territory of the governmental body and the information relates to:

(1) a trade secret of the business prospect; or

(2) commercial or financial information for which it is demonstrated based on specific factual evidence that disclosure would cause

substantial competitive harm to the person from whom the information was obtained.

(b) Unless and until an agreement is made with the business prospect, information about a financial or other incentive being offered to the business prospect by the governmental body or by another person is excepted from [required public disclosure].

Gov't Code § 552.131(a)-(b). We note the scope of section 552.131(a) is co-extensive with that of section 552.110 of the Government Code. *See id.* § 552.110(a)-(b). Because we have already disposed of Benning's claims for the information at issue under section 552.110, the university may not withhold any of the submitted information under section 552.131(a) of the Government Code. We note section 552.131(b) is designed to protect the interests of governmental bodies, not third parties. As the university does not assert section 552.131(b) as an exception to disclosure, we conclude no portion of the submitted information is excepted under section 552.131(b) of the Government Code.

Section 552.136 of the Government Code provides, "[n]otwithstanding any other provision of [the Act], a credit card, debit card, charge card, or access device number that is collected, assembled, or maintained by or for a governmental body is confidential."⁴ *Id.* § 552.136(b); *see id.* § 552.136(a) (defining "access device"). Accordingly, the university must withhold the account number we have marked under section 552.136 of the Government Code.

We note portions of the submitted information are subject to copyright law. A custodian of public records must comply with the copyright law and is not required to furnish copies of records that are copyrighted. Open Records Decision No. 180 at 3 (1977). A governmental body must allow inspection of copyrighted materials unless an exception applies to the information. *Id.*; *see* Open Records Decision No. 109 (1975). If a member of the public wishes to make copies of copyrighted materials, the person must do so unassisted by the governmental body. In making copies, the member of the public assumes the duty of compliance with the copyright law and the risk of a copyright infringement suit.


In summary, the university must withhold the account number we have marked under section 552.136 of the Government Code. The university must release the remaining information; however, any information subject to copyright may be released only in accordance with copyright law.

⁴The Office of the Attorney General will raise a mandatory exception on behalf of a governmental body, but ordinarily will not raise other exceptions. *See* Open Records Decision Nos. 481 (1987), 480 (1987), 470 (1987).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
