Re: Request for any and all records regarding any dispatches, 9-1-1 calls, police reports, offense reports, arrest reports, call logs, photographs, jail intake forms and jail visitation logs regarding a named individual for January 1, 2013 through January 31, 2014

Dear Ms. Clarke:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 535133.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information may be withheld from the requestor. First, we note report number 14-104-0027 is not responsive to the request because it does not involved the person named in the request. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
