Dear Ms. Martin:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 553920 (Police Dept. Reference No. 18076).

The Arlington Police Department (the "department") received a request for a specified police report. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.101 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

We note the submitted information was the subject of a previous request for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2014-23208 (2014). In that ruling, we concluded the department must withhold the submitted information we marked under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy, withhold the motor vehicle record information we marked under section 552.130 of the Government Code, and release the remaining information. We have no indication the law, facts, and circumstances on which Open Records Letter No. 2014-23208 was based have changed. Accordingly, we conclude the department must continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2014-23208 as a previous determination and withhold or release the submitted information in accordance with that ruling. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (so long as law, facts, circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where requested information is precisely same information as was addressed in prior attorney general ruling, ruling is addressed to same

governmental body, and ruling concludes that information is or is not excepted from disclosure).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
