Re: Request for any and all records related to a named individual

Dear Mr. Gatten:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 560933 (City of Fort Worth PIR# W039867).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information is excepted from public disclosure pursuant to sections 552.101 and 552.108 of the Government Code. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. You further assert submitted report numbers 12-64849 and 12-50198 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the submitted information. However, you must release the basic information from report numbers 12-64849 and 12-50198 pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
