Re: Request for 5 categories of information regarding a named individual including GPD Nos. 2015R000536, 2014R027405 and 2015R001573; any and all 911 recordings, police reports, arrest records, photos and/or statements; also any and all 911 recordings, police reports, arrest records, photos and/or statements made against the individual with the Garland Police Department during the previous 2 years; GCA15-0120

Dear Mr. Dempsey:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 563353.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. First, we note you have not submitted information responsive to the request for three specified report numbers. Thus, we assume you have released these reports. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302. You claim the remaining information may be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
