Dear Mr. Meurer:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 559117.

The Laredo Community College (the "college"), which you represent, received a request for information in a named college official's personnel file pertaining to administrative leave. You state the college does not assert any exceptions to disclosure on its own behalf for the submitted information. You further state the release of such information may implicate the interests of the named official. Accordingly, you inform us you notified the named official of the request and her right to submit arguments to this office as to why her information should not be released. Gov't Code § 552.304 (interested third party may submit comments stating why information should or should not be released). As of the date of this letter, we have not received comments from the named official explaining why the submitted should not be released. We have reviewed the submitted information. As no exceptions to disclosure have been raised for this information, it must be released to the requestor.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
