Re: Request for copies of any and all 911 calls or any type of investigations/reports regarding any incidents requiring law enforcement involving two named individuals between 1994 to present; along with any and all documents/things concerning and relating to the described incident; City of Midland ORR #16772

Dear Ms. Brooks:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 574162.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
