Re: Request for information regarding all incidents and slips from 2007 to 2015 involving named individuals at named address; HCSO File No. 14SO600677

Dear Ms. Fillion:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 574599.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information may be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individuals, who are not the requestor, as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. As for your claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold Exhibit B1. However, you must release the basic information from Exhibit B1 pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
