Dear Ms. Benton:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 581220 (City Reference No. LGL-15-248).

The City of Waco (the "city") received a request for information pertaining to a named individual and a specified investigation. You claim portions of the submitted information are excepted from disclosure under sections 552.101, 552.108, and 552.152 of the Government Code. We have considered the exceptions you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

We note the submitted information was the subject of previous requests for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2015-16352 (2015). In Open Records Letter No. 2015-16352, we determined, in part, the city may withhold the information it marked under section 552.108 of the Government Code. We have no indication the law, facts, or circumstances on which the prior ruling was based have changed. Accordingly, the city may continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2015-16352 as a previous determination and withhold or release the identical information in accordance with

that ruling. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 at 6-7 (2001) (discussing criteria for first type of previous determination).¹

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
