Dear Mr. Darby:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 581597.

The Edgewood Independent School District (the "district"), which you represent, received a request for information pertaining to arrests for specified types of offenses for specified time periods. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under sections 552.101, 552.103, and 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the exceptions you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

You state, and we agree, the submitted information was the subject of a previous request for information, as a result of which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2015-09143 (2015). In that decision, we ruled the district must withhold the submitted information under section 552.101 in conjunction with section 261.201(a) of the Family Code. There is no indication the law, facts, and circumstances on which the prior ruling was based have changed. Therefore, the district must continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2015-09143 as a previous determination and withhold the submitted information in accordance with that ruling.<sup>1</sup> See Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (explaining circumstances under which the first type of previous determination exists).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
