Re: Request for a copy of an offense report from 2010 where named individual was arrested at named address for assault family violence and any incidents he's been involved in. Pflugerville ORR # W003168-090215

Dear Ms. Newby-Cooley:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 588361.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. As for information concerning the specified 2010 arrest, in accordance with section 58.007 of the Family Code, you must withhold that information.
