Dear Mr. Guy:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 590224.

The Victoria County Criminal District Attorney's Office (the "district attorney's office") received two requests from the same requestor for information pertaining to a specified incident. You argue the requested information does not consist of public information subject to the Act. We have considered the submitted argument.

The district attorney's office asserts the requested information is not subject to the Act because it consists of records obtained pursuant to a grand jury subpoena and is held by the district attorney's office as an agent of the grand jury. The judiciary is expressly excluded from the requirements of the Act. Gov't Code § 552.003(1)(B). This office has determined for purposes of the Act, a grand jury is a part of the judiciary and therefore not subject to the Act. *See* Open Records Decision No. 411 (1984). Further, records kept by a governmental body that is acting as an agent for a grand jury are considered records in the constructive possession of the grand jury, and are also not subject to the Act. *See* Open Records Decisions Nos. 513 (1988), 411, 398 (1983). Thus, because the information at issue is held by the district attorney's office as an agent of the grand jury, this information consists of records of the judiciary not subject to disclosure under the Act. Therefore, the district attorney's office is not required to release the information in response to the instant request.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
