The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 592320.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information pertaining to report 15-30990 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) and the submitted information pertaining to report 15-30909 may be withheld pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the information and have determined that you may withhold the submitted information pertaining to report 15-30990 in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) and the submitted information pertaining to report 15-30909 in accordance with section 552.108(a)(2). However, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
