Dear Ms. Quinn:

The City of Cedar Park (the "city") received a request for all body camera video recordings from a named city police department officer related to a specified incident. Your request was assigned ID# 590846 (Ref. No. 15-1300).

We note the submitted information consists of a city police officer's body worn camera recording. Body worn cameras are subject to chapter 1701 of the Occupations Code. Chapter 1701 provides the procedures a requestor must follow when seeking a body worn camera recording. Section 1701.661(a) provides:

A member of the public is required to provide the following information when submitting a written request to a law enforcement agency for information recorded by a body worn camera:

- (1) the date and approximate time of the recording;
- (2) the specific location where the recording occurred; and
- (3) the name of one or more persons known to be a subject of the recording.

Act of May 30, 2015, 84th Leg., R.S., ch. 1134, § 1, 2015 Tex. Sess. Law Serv. 3818, 3820 (Vernon) (to be codified at Occ. Code § 1701.661(a)). In this instance, the requestor does

not give the requisite information under section 1701.661(a). As the requestor did not properly request the body worn camera recording at issue pursuant to chapter 1701, our ruling does not reach this information and it need not be released. Please note, however, pursuant to section 1701.661(b), a "failure to provide all the information required by Subsection (a) to be part of a request for recorded information does not preclude the requestor from making a future request for the same recorded information." *Id.* This office will consider this matter closed. If you have any questions with regard to this letter, please refer to ID# 590846.
