Re: Request for records pertaining to a named address and a named individual from 11/15/15 to 12/9/15 and 7/10 to 9/10; Report no. 151207002, CCPD File No. LSho1

Dear Mr. Garcia:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 599644.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. First, we note you have not submitted the specified, requested report number 1512070022. Thus, to the extent this report exists, we assume you have released it. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302. You claim the submitted information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
