Dear Ms. Doshier:

On January 27, 2016, this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2016-02069 (2016) to the Midlothian Police Department (the "department"), which you represent. You have informed this office that prior to the issuance of that ruling, the requestor voluntarily withdrew in writing his request for the information at issue, and you likewise submitted a letter dated January 18, 2016, asking to withdraw your request for a decision. Thus, by letter of February 8, 2016, you ask this office to withdraw Open Records Letter No. 2016-02069. Your request was assigned ID# 596109 (ORR# 74230).

In light of the requestor's withdrawal of his request to the department and your corresponding request to withdraw your request for a decision, this office retracts Open Records Letter No. 2016-02069 and replaces it with this withdrawal letter. Thus, the department need not comply with Open Records Letter No. 2016-02069. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .306. If the department receives another request for the same or similar information, it must seek another open records decision from this office. Accordingly, our office will consider this matter closed.
