Re: Request for all reports, and calls for service where a named individual is the accused or suspect. McKinney ORR # 16-18212

Dear Mr. Narvaez:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 606668.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. First, we note most of the information you submitted is not responsive to the request for reports naming the specified person as the accused or suspect. This decision does not address non-responsive information. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
