Dear Mr. De La Rose:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 606324.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You inform us you will release some of the submitted information. You claim the remaining submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the remaining submitted information. However, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code. Lastly, for any living persons' dates of birth contained in the information being released, you must withhold them, except for the requestor's, pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at *3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.).
