The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 611490.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim Exhibits C and D must be withheld from the requestor. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 261.201 of the Family Code, you must withhold Exhibits C and D pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code. Also, you must withhold the marked motor vehicle record information in Exhibit B under section 552.130 of the Government Code. Lastly, for any living persons' dates of birth contained in Exhibit B, you must withhold them pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at *3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.).
