The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 612202 (ORU No. 16-1819).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim Exhibit 2 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) and Exhibits 3 and 5 may be withheld pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the information and have determined that you may withhold Exhibit 2 in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) and Exhibits 3 and 5 in accordance with section 552.108(a)(2). However, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
