Dear Ms. Trevino:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 612491.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You have released most of Exhibit C and claim the information in Exhibit D may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the information in Exhibit D. However, you must release a detailed description of the offense as part of basic information in Exhibit D pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code. Also, you must withhold the dates of birth you have marked in Exhibit C pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at *3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.).
