Dear Ms. Vu:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 606123 (OOG #16-028).


The Office of the Governor (the "governor's office") received a request for the application submitted by the Alamo Area Council of Governments ("AACOG") for a specified grant. Although the governor's office takes no position as to the disclosure of the submitted information, you state that release of this information may implicate the privacy interests of the AACOG, the Department of the Air Force, and the Department of the Army. Accordingly, you state you have notified these third parties of the request and of the opportunity to submit comments to this office as to why the submitted information should not be released to the requestor. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (interested party may submit comments stating why information should or should not be released). We have considered the submitted information.

As of the date of this letter, we have not received any comments from any interested party explaining why any portion of the submitted information should not be released to the requestor. As no exceptions to disclosure have been raised, the governor's office must release the submitted information.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
